Transfer Agreement

Effective Date: For students admitted to UW-Madison Online on or after 06/01/2025

This document constitutes a transfer agreement between the University of Wisconsin-Madison School of Business and Oakton College. Students who earn the **Associate of Arts (AA) – Business/Accounting Pre-major** who meet requirements for admission to UW-Madison, who declare an intent to use this agreement to gain admission to the UW-Madison and who meet specified levels of academic achievement at Oakton College will be granted admission to UW–Madison School of Business **Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) online program: Business Administration-Management, Business Administration-Human Resources or Business Administration-Marketing** as a transfer student.

Students who do not use this transfer agreement are welcome to apply for admission via UW-Madison’s usual online transfer admission process.

This agreement only applies to the online Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) program: Business Administration-Management, Business Administration-Human Resources or Business Administration-Marketing at UW-Madison. Students who wish to pursue an on-campus program can follow the application process for on-campus transfer students. Online UW-Madison Business program students cannot transfer into any on-campus program.

1. Transfer Admission Requirements

Students are eligible for admission to UW-Madison online School of Business Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) Business Administration-Management, Business Administration-Human Resources or Business Administration-Marketing under this agreement if they:

- a. Complete the Associate of Arts (AA) – Business/Accounting Pre-major
- b. Meet with an advisor at Oakton College to review and submit a Declaration of Intent to Participate. The advisor will validate eligibility and submit the Declaration of Intent to Participate online form to the UW–Madison Office of Admissions and Recruitment. UW–Madison will email a copy of the Declaration of Intent to Participate to the student and Oakton College and UW-Madison Online.

- c. Complete a minimum of 62 transferable credits in the Associate of Arts (AA) – Business/Accounting Pre-major program.
- d. Complete MAT 140 College Algebra or equivalent course that transfers as MATH 112 or higher at UW-Madison prior to transfer
- e. Earn a 3.0 cumulative GPA in the Associate of Arts (AA) – Business/Accounting Pre-major course work as determined by UW–Madison computation. The GPA for transfer is computed in accordance with UW–Madison’s grading practices in which all grades for repeated and failed transferable courses are included in the computation.
- f. Meet the requirements for admission to UW-Madison
 - i. Provide proof of high school graduation through an official high school transcript or high school equivalency diploma.
 - ii. Demonstrate successful completion of:
 - 1. Algebra (one high school year or equivalent)
 - 2. Plane geometry (one high school year or equivalent)
 - 3. College preparatory math (one high school year or one college-level course)
 - 4. Single world language (two high school years or two college semesters of sequential study in one world language). A student whose native language is not English is exempt from this admission requirement provided the student’s formal education through the seventh grade was in the native language
- g. Apply for **online** transfer admission to UW-Madison according to the schedule for the planned term of entry to UW-Madison, see [Apply at UW Online](#)

2. Course Transfer from Oakton College

- a. Course transfer will be determined by UW-Madison Credit Evaluation Services. To determine how courses transfer from Oakton College to UW-Madison, see the Transferology website at www.transferology.com.
- b. To determine how test credit, such as Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB), transfers to UW-Madison, see [UW-Madison Guide](#)
- c. Previous coursework will be evaluated for transfer on a course-by-course basis. Courses transferred to or exempted by Oakton College may not satisfy UW-Madison course requirements.
- d. Students may transfer up to 72-degree credits earned at non-baccalaureate institutions.

3. Program Management and Reporting

Each institution will:

- a. Assess student progress and experiences to inform modification and/or improvement of the agreement.
- b. Exchange information that may be helpful in advising students and pertinent to the academic success of participating students.

c. Provide timely information about significant changes in the program of study that relates to the preparation of participating students.


4. Termination/Modification

a. This Agreement is subject to change or modification by mutual written consent.

b. This Agreement may be modified by UW-Madison, in consultation with Oakton College, as may be necessary to bring it within the purview of and in accord with the directives of the Provost of UW-Madison, the Statutes governing UW-Madison, or the policies of the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System.

c. This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon 1 year written notice to the other party. It is understood and agreed that any student already admitted to Oakton College or UW-Madison due to this Agreement will be allowed to complete the program notwithstanding the termination provision, so long as the student remains in good academic standing and is making measured progress toward completion of a degree program. Notice of change or termination should be sent to the Oakton College Office of College Transitions, Academic Affairs and to UW Madison's Office of Admission and Recruitment and UW-Madison Online.



Oakton College Associate of Arts – Business/Accounting Pre-major To UW-Madison Online Bachelor of Business Administration Management, Human Resources or Marketing

This transfer pathway serves as a sample mapping tool for students and is based upon current transfer equivalencies and current program requirements as outlined in the 2025/2026 Academic Catalog. While this pathway has been created to assist you with your potential course options prior to transfer, it is not part of the official transfer agreement and is subject to change or error and not binding. It is strongly recommended that you continue to work with your advisor during the transfer process.

Transfer Guide Highlights:

- A minimum of 62 credits taken at Oakton College will transfer to UW-Madison. If a student transfers in course work from another institution to fulfill requirements within the AA, it will be evaluated from the institution where it was completed and not how it transferred to Oakton College.
- As few as 58 credits are needed to complete this degree at UW-Madison Online.
- Required completion of MAT 140 College Algebra or equivalent course that transfers as MATH 112 to UW-Madison or higher math prior to transfer.
- **This pathway is exclusively to transfer into the UW-Madison Online BBA major. Online students are not eligible to transfer into any on-campus majors.**
